### ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE

#### Functions of Anti Raging Committee:

1. Ensures that at least one faculty member will be present at any particular time at all the locations to avoid ragging activities.
2. Takes precautions to avoid ragging activities at other locations like bus stops and gives instructions to the student volunteers and secret informers at various boarding points.
3. Canvases about anti-ragging in the forms of Flexes, Posters and Boards in college premises and surrounding areas where there is a chance of ragging.
4. Arranges counseling and guidance programs arranged for the fresher's and parents regarding ragging. Takes affidavits from the students and parents regarding Ragging during the Admission.
5. Provides helpline details inside and outside college premises.
6. Resolves the complaint received from the victim
7. Verifies the facts through enquiry
8. Awards disciplinary action against culprit.

#### **Procedure for lodging complaint:**

The students may feel free to put up a grievance in writing/or Email to the respective committee in charge. The Grievance Cell will act upon those cases which have been forwarded along with the necessary documents. The Grievance Cell will assure that the grievance has been properly solved in a stipulated time limit provided by the cell.

<b>What constitutes Ragging?</b>	<b>Punishment to those found guilty</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• As per the order of Honorable Supreme Court of India and subsequent Notification from University Grants Commission (UGC), ragging constitutes one or more of any intention by any student or group of students.</li> <li>• Any act of Indiscipline, Teasing or Handling with Rudeness.</li> <li>• Any act that Prevents, Disrupts the Regular Academic Activity.</li> <li>• Any activity which is likely to cause Annoyance, Hardship, Psychological Harm or creates Fear or Apprehension.</li> <li>• Any Act of Financial Extortion or Forceful Expenditure.</li> <li>• Any Act of Physical Abuse causing Assault, Harm or danger to Health.</li> <li>• Any Act of abuse by spoken words, emails, SMS or public insult etc.</li> <li>• Any Act of injury or infringement of the fundamental right to the human dignity.</li> <li>• Any Act of Wrongful Confinement, Kidnapping, molesting or committing unnatural offences, use of criminal forces, trespass or intimidation.</li> <li>• Any unlawful assembly or conspiracy to ragging</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging in the campus or event outside the campus shall be liable to one or more of the following punishments given below.</li> <li>• Debarring from appearing in any Midterm test University Examination.</li> <li>• Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.</li> <li>• Withdrawing scholarships and other benefits.</li> <li>• Suspended from the University for a period of three months.</li> <li>• Expulsion from the University and also debarring from admission to any other institution throughout India.</li> <li>• Entry in the character / Transfer Certificate regarding the punishment given for any Act if ragging.</li> </ul>
