MINUTES OF MEETING


In the first meeting of BOS in Computer Science and Engineering (Cyber Security) Department of Sri Indu Institute of Engineering and Technology (Autonomous), the Principal, SIET welcomed all the members of BOS in Computer Science and Engineering (Cyber Security) Department. Courses. 
The Chairman, BOS, thanked all the members for being present, and for their co-operation in approving all the items of the Agenda.




