As per JNTUH relaxation for the detained students B.Tech I Year to B.Tech II Year has been given by decreasing the credits from 50% to 25%, B.Tech II Year to B.Tech III Year from 60% to 25%, and No Credit-Based detention is applicable for B.Tech III Year students advancing to B.Tech IV Year under R22 Regulations.

Sri Indu Institute of Engineering and Technology (Autonomous) will implement the revised 25% credit criteria for promoting students from B.Tech I Year to II Year, B.Tech II Year to III Year, and there will be No Credit-Based detention for B.Tech III Year to IV Year students, all under BR22 Regulations.

These changes will be effective from the academic year 2023-24 for BR22 Regulations.
